COVID-19 protocols to help keep everyone safe and dancing:

1. We are running NASA grade, Beyond Pure Air Purifying systems in both dance studios as well as the lobby. These systems are proved to kill germs not only in the air, completely renewed every hour, but also on all surfaces in the room.

2. In addition, the instructors are sanitizing the floors, barres, and door knobs in between every class.

3. Masks are required in the lobby area and are recommended in classes*. If you want your child to wear a mask during class, please make sure both your child and the instructor know so we can properly enforce your wishes.

4. A [COVID-19 Liability release form](#) must be signed by the dancers parent or guardian before the dancer may enter the studio. You can sign the online form or fill out a physical form at the outside desk.

5. Touchless temperature checks will be conducted as dancers enter the main door, and if the child's temperature is above the recommended 100.4 degrees, we will not allow them to participate - you will be given a make-up class pass to use when they are fever free for 48 hours.

6. Hand sanitizer or washing is required upon entering the building before a class. If there is a snack or dinner break, dancers must wash/sanitize hands before reentering the class.

7. View class from outside – please take advantage of the benches and table in the front, as well as extra chairs we set out daily. We cannot allow more than 3 spectators inside the lobby at a time.

8. All dancers are asked to wait outside before, after and in-between classes. Dancers will be invited to enter once the previous class has exited and the studio has been sanitized.

*When inside we ask that you follow the state mandate regarding face coverings, unless you are prohibited due to a medical condition outlined in the mandate. We ask that everyone be kind to one another regarding this, as there are several medical reasons for not wearing a face covering that may not be outwardly obvious to others. Please be kind.
